Another Mil Ex coming up in October - November (Wallaby 2005) ensure you read AIP SUP H42/05. It will enlighten you on the restricted and danger areas being activated during the exercise.

The Exercise aircraft include: Supa Pumas, C130s and from early November F16s.

Other things to note:

1. The arrestor cable will be used for the F16s (be aware of remaining distances and displaced threshold distances when in use)
2. Runway 04/22 will be partially closed for the parking of the Pumas (again be aware of distances remaining)

Some pilots are still failing to request an intersection departure. If you wish to depart from an intersection e.g. from taxiway Foxtrot you should call ready and request intersection departure. Otherwise we are unsure if you need to backtrack.

It just makes things run a bit smoother if we know where you intend to depart from.
